TESTIMONIES

Jean-Claude was born in Port-au-Prince, Haiti, and immigrated to the United States with his parents when he was 13. Matilde was born in Cali, Colombia, and moved to the United States when she was 19.

In 1975, they met in New York City and were married in April, 1976. They have four children—Alexandra, Fernand, Henri-Kristoff and Jean-Paul—and seven grandchildren.

When preparing to study architecture in college, Jean-Claude was told by a man whom he sketched that he would be a preacher, but thought nothing of it.

In 1979, Jean-Claude was introduced to a pastor by his wife's hospital roommate and after a visit from the pastor, he was saved. For two years, he took their young children to church without his wife. Finally in 1981, Matilde went to church and accepted Christ as her Savior during the invitation.
