STATEMENT OF FAITH

MWBM Holds to these Truths:

- 1. The plenary, verbal, Divine inspiration of Scripture, consisting only of the 39 Old Testament and 27 New Testament books, in the original language, their consequent inerrancy and infallibility, and as the Word of God, the supreme and final authority in faith and life. (We believe that the Word of God has been divinely preserved in the King James Version of the Bible for English speaking people.)
- The triune God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, the Sovereign Creator, Sustainer and Ruler of the Universe.
- 3. The essential, absolute, eternal Deity and the real and proper, and sinless humanity of our Lord Jesus Christ; His virgin birth; His substitutionary, expiatory death; His resurrection from among the dead in the same body in which He was crucified; and the bodily return of this same Jesus to the earth in power and great glory to judge the earth and establish His Millennial Kingdom.
- 4. The "blessed hope" of the Christian in the personal, pretribulational, premillennial, and imminent coming of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ to gather the Church "which is His body" unto Him.
- 5. That the Holy Spirit enters, seals, and baptizes one the moment he is born into the family of God through faith in Jesus Christ; that He endues, guides, teaches, sanctifies, empowers, and keeps the believer eternally secure.
- 6. That salvation is the effect of regeneration by the Spirit and the Word, not by works but by grace through faith in the shed blood of Christ.
- 7. The abiding presence and ministry of the Holy Spirit in each regenerate life.
- 8. The everlasting bliss of the saved in Heaven, and the everlasting suffering of the lost in the lake of fire.
- The real spiritual unity in Christ of all who are redeemed by His precious blood.
- The necessity of maintaining, according to the Word of God, the purity of the church doctrine and life.
- 11. The ordinances of the local church which are believer's baptism by immersion only and the Lord's Supper.
- 12. The obligation of obedience in the command of Christ to evangelize the world and to establish local churches.
- 13. MWBM, Inc. is pretribulational, premillennial, fund-amental in doctrine, and separatist in practice, opposing modernism, ecumenicalism, neo-evangelicalism and the charismatic movement.

Macedonia World Baptist Missions, Inc. (MWBM) is located in Hoschton, Georgia on eight acres of property, fifty miles northeast of Atlanta, Georgia. The campus includes the main 10,400 sq. ft. administrative office, 10,800 sq. ft. training facility, and 5,000 sq. ft. printing and publications building, all of which are debt free.

The office staff of Macedonia World Baptist Missions, Inc. is dedicated to providing the best service possible to Independent Baptist Churches as they send and support their missionaries in going forth to reach the world for Christ. The staff is made up of men and ladies who have served on foreign fields and in their local churches here in the States. With this personal perspective of missions, they are better able to understand and care for the needs of the missionaries on the field and better train missionaries going to the field.

Detailed financial records are maintained for each donation to each missionary or project, and a tax deductible receipt is issued for each donation. Other services such as group life insurance and overseas group health are provided for the missionaries.

MISSIONARY HERITAGE TRAINING CENTER

Missionary Training includes a two-day Basic orientation for missionaries who are beginning deputation. Training ranges from expense reporting, to designing prayer cards, putting together presentations and display boards, contacting pastors, and many other topics.
